Before creation, the grace of God chose some people to be saved. He planned for them a destiny of eternal fellowship with God in heaven. Here are seven spiritual blessings that we believers have because Jesus died for our sins and rose again: (1) **Chosen** to be holy and without blame; (2) **adopted** into the position of adult sons; (3) **accepted** in Christ, God's beloved; (4) **redeemed** and forgiven from our sins by the blood of Jesus Christ; (5) **knowledge** of the mystery of His will, that all believers are the church; (6) **inheritance** with Christ in heaven; (7) **the seal and earnest of the Spirit** is a guarantee for the believer that he is going to heaven. Also, the earnest of the Spirit helps us to enjoy Christ now before we get to heaven.

The Apostle Paul thanked God for the faith of the Ephesian believers and their love to all saints, not to just a certain group of believers. Also, they were learning to know more about Jesus Christ whom God has raised from the dead and put Him in the highest place in heaven and given Him a name above all others.
