GALATIANS 1

False teachers came to Galatia with a different gospel than the Apostle Paul had taught them. This false gospel forced everyone to try to keep the law. There is no grace in the law. Paul was saved by grace. God sent Paul to tell the heathen Gentiles about God's grace. This means Jesus died for everyone, not just the Jews. What about you? Have you admitted your sin to Jesus and asked Him to save you? Paul came to Jerusalem to visit with Peter for fifteen days. The Christians here knew that Paul had persecuted the church in the past. Paul would disturb meetings, beat and arrest Christians, and kill some of them. These Christians gave glory to God because there was a change in Paul. He had been saved by grace and now he was preaching salvation by faith in Jesus Christ.
