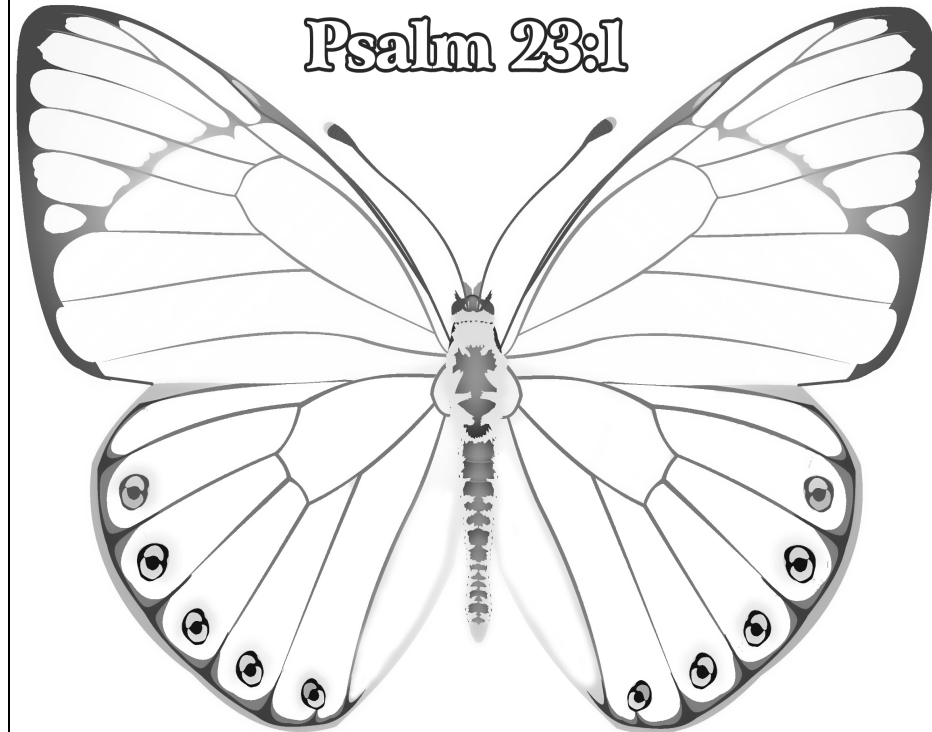

Follow God. Christ loved us and gave Himself to die for us as a sacrifice to God. We should follow His example and give of ourselves to love one another. This will make God happy. Unbelievers do bad things because they are not the children of God. When a believer is saved, he begins to stop doing the bad. God wants us to have Christian friends who love the Lord Jesus and to follow the example of the Lord Jesus. If we love the Lord Jesus, we will not have fellowship with unbelievers because they will get us to sin against God. The unbelievers are in darkness. We Christians are taught to walk in the light of God's Word. If we read the Bible, we can learn to understand the will of God for us. Instead of having our minds filled with the darkness and pleasures of the world, we are told not to be drunk with wine but to be filled with the Spirit. The Spirit of God will make us happy to sing praises to the Lord, to give thanks to God, and to submit to one another. Next, Paul talks to your father and mother. If your father is filled with the Spirit, he will love your mom even if she does not respect him. If your mom is filled with the Spirit, she will respect your father even if he does not show love to her. Christ and the church He loved and for whom He gave Himself are an example for a husband and wife to love and respect one another.

FEAR

The Bible mentions fear many times, and each of us has been afraid at some point in our lives. We can be afraid of other people, or car accidents, or snakes, or sickness, or death. We can be afraid of storms, or thieves, or the future, or even Satan himself. One type of fear commended in the Bible is the fear of the Lord. To fear God means to have a holy respect for the Lord and His Word. The Lord wants us to live a life without fear except for fearing Him. Notice as you read the Scriptures how many times the Lord says, "Fear not" or "Be not afraid." How do we live a life free from fear? King David knew the answer to that question. In Psalm 56:3, he says, "What time I am afraid, I will trust in Thee." When we are afraid, we need to look to the Lord and trust both ourselves and our situation to Him. In Hebrews 13:5, the Lord tells us, "I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee." That gives us the courage to continue with verse 6, "So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me."
