EPHESIANS 3

Verses 3, 4 and 9 mention the mystery that is hidden in God. The mystery is the purpose of God to remove all differences He had between Jews and Gentiles and put them together in one body. God called this one body of believers the church. At first the gospel went to the Jews only, but then God sent Paul to bring the gospel to the Gentiles. I am very happy that God included Gentiles in the church, because I am not a Jew. The mystery about the church was given by the Spirit of God to Paul only to write in the Bible. Paul teaches us how we, the church, should behave together. The principalities and powers in verse 10 are the angels, who watch you and me. They see how God has put us together in the church. The angels are learning the wisdom of God by watching His love and care for the church. They see that we have access to come and talk to the Lord Jesus at any time. In verses 13-19, Paul prays for the Ephesians that through the Spirit they may understand the great love of Christ and our glorious salvation. We believers today enjoy the same love and care and fellowship because we are part of the same church as the Ephesians. The church will be giving glory to God through all eternity.

CLOUDS

In Bible times, God often used clouds to veil both His presence and His power. When the law was given to Moses, we read in Exodus 24:16 that "the glory of the Lord abode upon mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days: and the seventh day He called unto Moses out of the midst of the cloud." And when King Solomon completed and dedicated the house of the Lord, "the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the Lord; so that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the glory of the Lord had filled the house of God" (2 Chronicles 5:13-14). We also find that when the Lord Jesus returned to heaven, a cloud received Him out of the disciples' sight (Acts 1:9). If you look for clouds in your Bible, you will find many more instances of God's presence and power in the clouds. Today we often think of clouds as times of suffering and sunny days as joyful, happy times. However, the clouds are a sign that God is there. Sorrow, bereavement and suffering are clouds in our lives that come along with God. Both His presence and His power are with us in difficult times. We just need to look by faith beyond the clouds.
