### EPHESIANS 4

We are told to walk worthy of our calling to practice the truth that we are one body with all other believers. Each believer has the same faith and the same hope as all other believers. We should practice this truth, while keeping the unity of the Spirit, with humility and meekness, and forbearing with one another in love. This unity is not agreement with each other—we should agree with the Holy Spirit.

Unity of the Spirit is the oneness of the members of the body of Christ, which the Holy Spirit has established. It takes grace and diligence and obedience to the Word of God to practice this unity on the earth. We should obey the one Lord and walk in agreement with the one Spirit.

The Holy Spirit has given spiritual gifts to believers to teach and encourage the body of Christ so we can be spiritually strong Christians.

In verses 17-32, we are encouraged to have a pure life and to be angry at sin. If we are angry at sin, it will help to keep us from doing sin. If we begin to think that a certain sin is not so bad, we will start to do that sin. But do not be angry at other people. Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake has forgiven you.

### CROWNS

Today when we think of crowns, we usually think of a crown that a king or queen would wear as a symbol of royalty. Crowns of royalty are used in the New Testament only in reference to the Lord Jesus, as in Revelation 19:12, "His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns." Only the Lord Jesus is worthy to wear crowns of royalty as the King of kings and the Lord of lords. Many of the other New Testament verses that mention crowns really mean a symbol of victory rather than royalty. We find crowns promised to believers who are victorious in their Christian life. We are encouraged to practice self-control and self-denial as we follow Christ so that we may receive a crown that will not perish (1 Corinthians 9:24-26). Also, we should not give up but continue living for Christ as we wait for His return so that no one will take our crown (Revelation 3:11). One crown we should never forget about is the crown of thorns in John 19:2 that was put on the head of the Lord Jesus. Pilate and the soldiers mocked the Lord, both as King and Victor. Thorns are a symbol of the curse of man's sin. The Lord Jesus bore the curse of our sins so that we may wear a crown of glory. And one day the Lord will return to this earth as both King and Victor.
