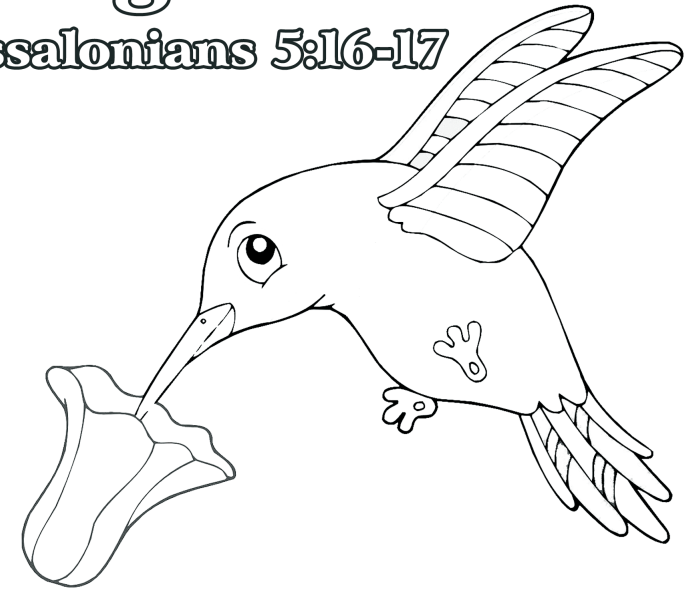

JESUS' BLOOD

If we have trusted in the Lord Jesus, the Bible quite clearly tells us in 1 John 1:7 and in Revelation 1:5 that Jesus' blood has washed away or cleansed our sins. The price for the cleansing of our sins was enormous. The cost was far more than we could ever pay. Only Jesus, by giving up His life and shedding His blood, could pay it for us. At least five times God tells us that we also have redemption through Jesus' blood. You can look up these verses in Ephesians 1:7, Colossians 1:14, Hebrews 9:12, 1 Peter 1:18-19 and Revelation 5:9. Because we have redemption through His blood, we are free both from the power of sin and from the guilt of sin. In two of these verses, we also learn that redemption through Jesus' blood means that we have God's forgiveness of our sins. This is a result of Jesus paying the penalty for our sins with His blood. We find throughout the New Testament that God performs several other actions for us, all on the basis of Jesus' death and His shed blood.
