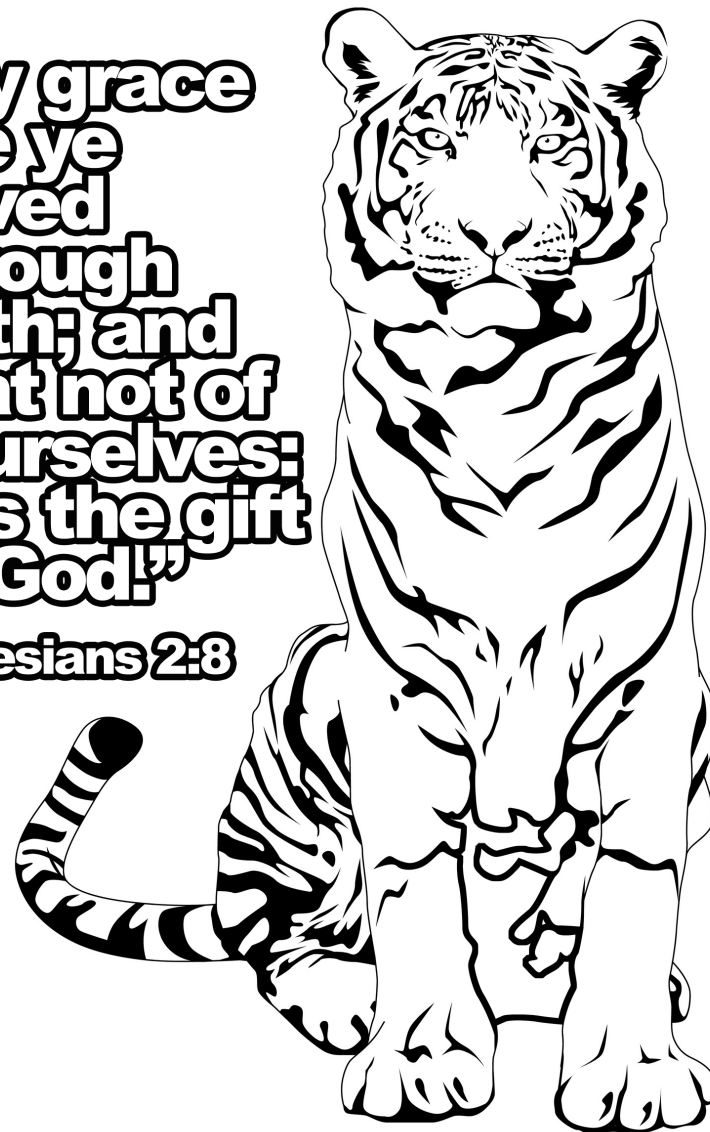

RIGHT HAND

We can see throughout the Bible that the right hand is considered the position of greatest honor. For example, in 1 Kings 2:19, King Solomon had his mother sit at his right hand. We can also read in Exodus 15:6 and in Matthew 26:64 that the right hand is a symbol of power. Finally, we find out in Psalm 16:11 that the right hand is also a place of delight. Therefore, to be seated at God's right hand is a place of supreme honor and unlimited power and immeasurable delight. We know from many verses in the Bible that Jesus is now seated at God's right hand. Mark 16:19 says concerning the Lord's ascension to heaven after He was risen from the dead, "So then after the Lord had spoken unto them [the disciples], He was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God." Our Lord Jesus is the One to be honored and worshipped. He has all power and will soon wield that power in the world. Christ Jesus is in a place of perfect happiness. Before too much longer, any of us who know Christ as our Saviour will share in the Lord's glory, power and joy. Because of who the Lord is and what He has done for us, we can have a worshipful heart and a thankful attitude as we look at a few verses about the Lord being at God's right hand.
